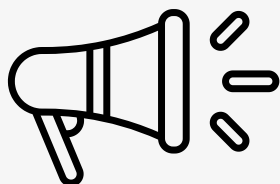

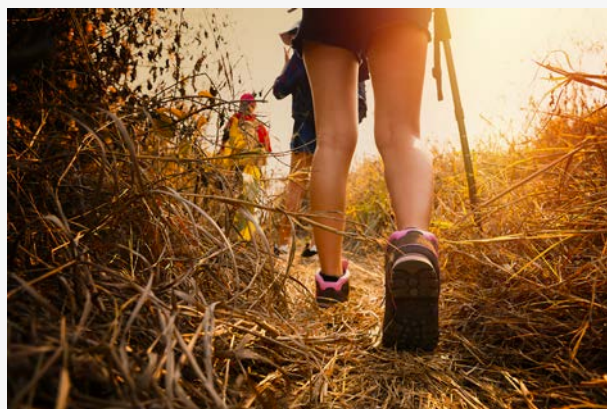
AROUND TOWN EVENTS
