Thank you for your cooperation, as safety is a top priority for our residents and team members.

TIPS FOR FREEZE WARNINGS

1 Always be sure to have the heating system turned on, especially when leaving your home.

2 We strongly suggest leaving thermostat set to a temperature of 60-65 degrees at minimum.

3 During periods of freezing temperatures opening cabinet doors will allow warm air to circulate around plumbing to avoid any potential pipe freezing.

4 Turning faucets on to a very minimal drip will also allow water circulation to prevent pipes from freezing.

5 Common area and shared sidewalk snow removal is done by on-site staff with accumulation of two inches or greater- this begins once snow stops accumulating!

6 Keeping curtains and blinds closed will also help keep the maximum amount of heat inside the home.

7 We do not recommend warming up cars in any garages (attached or detached) without opening your garage door at least twelve inches to prevent any issues with carbon monoxide produced by the vehicle.
