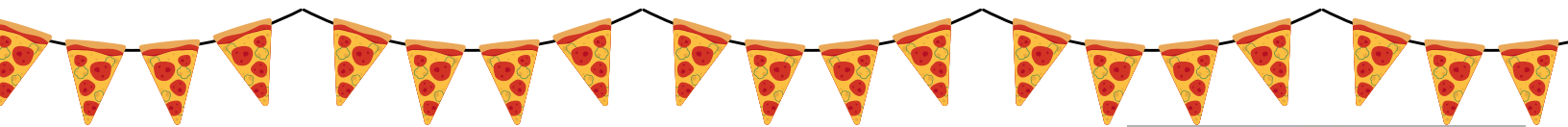
Late Night Swim

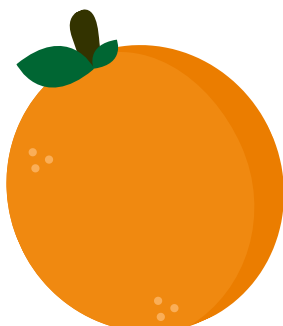
